

Arriving from the North (Virginia, Washington DC)

- ◆ Following I-85 South, towards Charlotte
- ◆ Exit at 122A and turn Right onto Groometown Road
- ◆ Turn Left at the first stoplight, onto Grandover Parkway
- ◆ The resort entrance is on the right, about 1.3 miles down

Arriving from the South (Charlotte, Atlanta)

- ◆ Follow I-85 North, towards Greensboro
- ◆ Exit at 119 and turn Left onto Groometown Road
- ◆ Turn left at the second stoplight, onto Grandover Parkway
- ◆ The resort entrance is on the right, about 1.3 miles down

Arriving from the South (Asheboro, Pinehurst, Southern Pines)

- ◆ Follow I-220/Hwy 73 North, towards Greensboro
- ◆ Exit at 78B to Groometown Road
- ◆ Follow the loop all the way to Groometown Road and turn Right
- ◆ Turn Left at the next traffic light onto Grandover Parkway
- ◆ The resort entrance is on the right, about 1.3 miles down

Arriving from the East (Durham, Raleigh)

- ◆ Follow I-40 West to Greensboro
- ◆ Take the I-85 South Exit and bear to the Right to take the Groometown Road exit
- ◆ Turn right onto Groometown Road
- ◆ Turn Left at the first stoplight, onto Grandover Parkway
- ◆ The resort entrance is on the right, about 1.3 miles down

Arriving from the West (Winston-Salem, Asheville, Hickory, Mt. Airy)

- ◆ Follow I-40 East to Greensboro
- ◆ Take the I-85 South Exit and bear to the Right to take the Groometown Road exit
- ◆ Turn Right onto Groometown
- ◆ Turn Left at the first stoplight, onto Grandover Parkway
- ◆ The resort entrance is on the right, about 1.3 miles down
