

Grandover Hosts 2013 Annual Meetings NC Poultry Federation & NC Egg Association

Venue for the NCPF's 46th Annual Meeting was the Grandover Conference Center, Greensboro, which also hosted the NC Egg Association's Annual Membership Meeting. A total of 260 registered from the Federation, Egg Association, Sponsors, and Allied Members. Tournament golfers numbering 120 and 28 sporting clays competitors set a record turnout. The NCPF presidential gavel was passed from Scott Prestage to Dan Peugh during the Banquet and Awards Ceremony. Dan and the Board of Directors will serve the NCPF for the coming year, 2013-14. 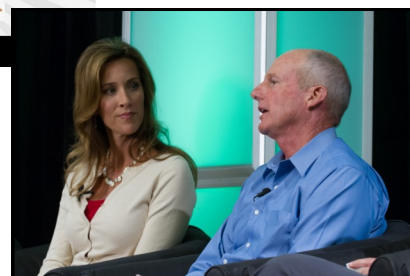

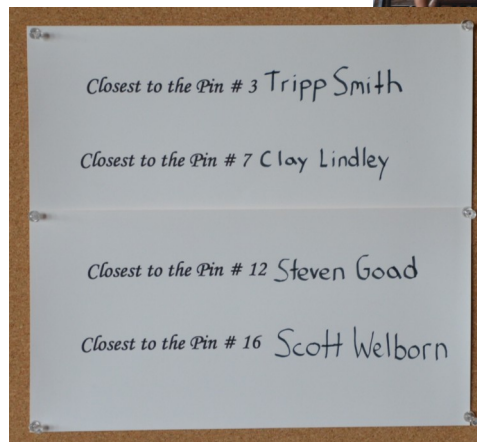

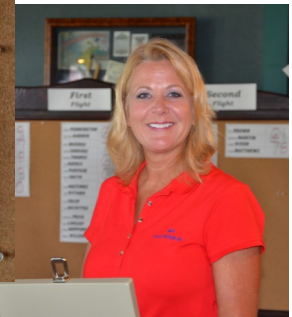
